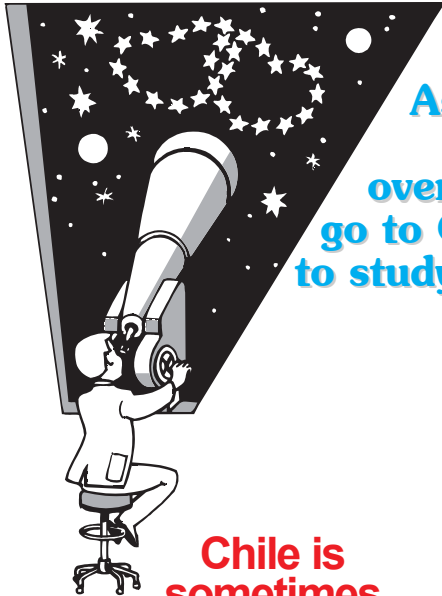

As least one earthquake occurs somewhere in Chile every day

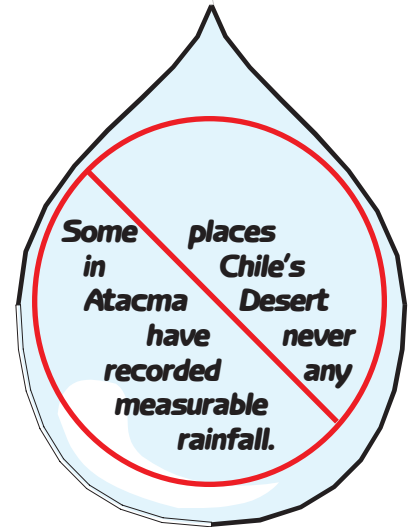
Astronomers from all over the world go to Chile to study the stars.



Chile is sometimes called the "Shoestring Nation" because of its long, thin shape.

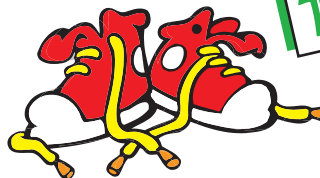


Chile includes many islands, including Easter Island, which was discovered on Easter Sunday.
