Please pray for us and the CiGu English Camp this Sunday to Thursday, January 20-24, 2008. We will be there Monday to Thursday. Carmen will go to her Kindergarten classes, while Jacob, Sarah and I will drive to CiGu, about one and a half hour away from our place. Pray for traveling mercies. We will be traveling three hours each day for four days. Sarah will be teaching children, grades 4-6, and I will be with grades 1-3. Pray for the team members from Feng Shan Free Methodist Church (FSFMC). Pray that both the children and their parents from the CiGu community will know Jesus as their Savior.

Also, during the Chinese New Year, February 6-9, 2008, Nantze Higher Ground Community Church (NHGCC), a local church for Filipino migrant workers here in Kaohsiung, will host a retreat.
