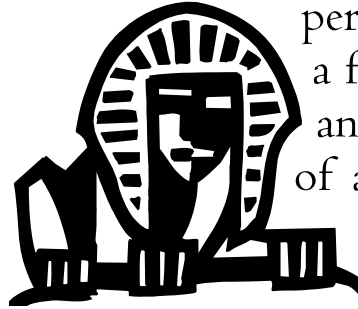

A sphinx shows the head of a person, perhaps a former king, and the body of a lion.

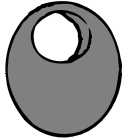


Fifty ships a day pass through the Suez Canal. It is the shortest route between Europe and the Indian Ocean. It'll take a ship 15 hours to get through the canal.

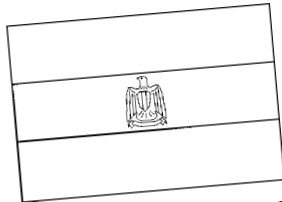


The Sinai Peninsula links Africa and Asia.
