### Cambodia update

- Thanks for praying for the Global Studies Intensive. We heard that it went very well and impacted the lives of those who attended.

- Two baptismal services were held recently: 10 new believers from Kampong Cham declared their faith in Christ, and 17 from Kampot

One more prayer request - our college grads are having a hard time finding jobs, as factories have closed and other possible job openings have recently dried up.

### Trip plans

We are schedule to take off just after midnight on March 6 from San Francisco. We'll have a very brief layover in Hong Kong (no time to visit any friends there), and then arrive in Phnom Penh on Saturday morning, March 7.

March 12 we'll fly to Bangkok for the Asia Leadership Team meetings there. On Monday evening, March 16, David & Sherrill Yardy, Jim, Deb & John Wilson, Don & Kathy Williams, and the two of us will fly to Hyderabad, India. After 2 days visiting Free Methodist ministries there, we'll go by land to Umri and Yavatmal, and spend another 2 days there. March 21 we'll fly to Mumbai, worship Sunday morning in FM churches there, and then Sunday night fly overnight to Bangkok.

Jim & I and the Wilsons will then fly on to Manila on Monday, March 23. We'll be involved in the Asia Pacific Free Methodist Missions Association (APFMMA) Executive Committee meetings through the 26<sup>th</sup>, and then on Friday, March 27, fly down to Butuan City, where Jim is scheduled to speak at the graduation for the Light & Light Bible College and Light & Life Graduate School of Theology on March 29.

Monday, March 30, we'll fly back to Manila, and Tuesday we'll head back home to California (via Hong Kong again, and again with a very short layover), arriving in San Francisco at 11:35 a.m.!

We've put in all this detail so that you can pray for us in all these travels - for safety, good health, effective and Spirit-filled meetings, good fellowship with old and new friends, etc., etc.
