On June 10th we heard from a dear brother in Christ from Myanmar (formally Burma) who Don was able to visit with last year. What follows is his update. Please be in prayer for him, his family and the ministry taking place in Rangoon and throughout the country. There are some very specific prayer requests included.

*Dear Don,*

*While here in Bangkok though I was able to open your blog and read all about Myanmar. Thank you so much for extending information about our ministries in Myanmar. I have found that people are very interested in Myanmar but find it difficult of how to tell them.*

*I have attached a letter about our boarding school students and the results from their matriculation exams. Also I have attached a photo of my father's church in the Chin State (the first FMC in Myanmar). His church is wanting to re-build because of the condition but needs approximately \$5,000 U.S. dollars for this project. Also, as you will read in the letter, one of our students (Mr. Van Lian Thang) that passed his exam with four subject distinctions would like to study medicine but will need financial assistance. In Myanmar, there are very few Christian medical doctors so this is a very special opportunity we have. I have also attached a photo of this student.*

*I attach three photos: Mr. Van Lian Thang, my father's church and our boarding students in 2008-09 academic year.*
