Three, please pray for the Chinese church in Burma. Pray for Esther as she leads this ministry.

Four, for the church in Thailand. For potential ministry opportunities at Zionland, for Joshua's church in Chiang Mai as they don't have enough chairs or space for the growing congregation and for the plans to develop a ministry center and the resources needed in Chiang Mai.

Five, for the wide-open ministry opportunities in Cambodia.
